

Fall Planting Instructions

Bulbs shown should be planted prior to the ground freezing to a depth of more than three inches. Detailed planting instructions are printed on each package of bulbs.

	HEIGHT	BLOOM	NOTES
Daffodils	18 - 22"	April	Plant 7" deep, 7" apart in sun or partial shade.
Tulips	18 - 30"	April - May	Plant 6" deep, 6" apart in well-drained soil. Likes sun.
Hyacinths	8 - 10"	April	Plant 5" deep, 6" apart in full sun.
Paper White Narcissus	16 - 18"	4 to 5 weeks	Plant indoors in soil, stones, or sand (any medium that will support root growth). Plant with top of bulb just above soil, or with water level at base of bulb.
Crocus	5"	March	Plant 3" deep, 3" apart in sun or partial shade.
Purple Drumstick	2 - 3'	May - June	Plant 4" deep, 4 - 6" apart in full sun.
Lilies	3 - 4'	July - September	Plant 4" deep, 6" apart.
Iris	12"	June	Plant 4" deep, 4" apart in loosened soil.
Windflowers	5"	April	Plant 2" deep, 2 - 4" apart in full sun.
Alpine Bells	10 - 16"	June	Plant 4" deep, 6 - 8" apart in full sun.
Heavenly Blue Bells	4 - 6"	April - May	Plant 4" deep, 3" apart in sun or partial shade.
Striped Squill	4 - 6"	March - April	Plant 3" deep, 3" apart in full sun or partial shade.
